

## KPAF Poker Run Rules – June 4, 2011

- **Early registration is \$30 or \$40** on June 4<sup>th</sup>. Registration locations:
  - Kenai Airport Manager's office, 305 N. Willow, Suite 200, tel: 283-7951.
  - City of Soldotna Maintenance Dept. 340 Arbor Ave. Soldotna, tel: 262-4672
  - June 4 - MARC hangar at Soldotna Airport between 8am and 11am or at the Kenai Operations Facility from 12pm-2pm

Each individual's registration fee entitles the participant to an Air Fair souvenir T-shirt, EAA breakfast, barbeque lunch at Kenai Airport, and a chance to win great prizes based on your poker hand.

- Participants may pilot their own plane **or be a passenger** in a registered aircraft.
- To enter a participant must:
  1. Be registered. Registration is **mandatory**; however, tickets may be picked up at other locations before registering. Example, a flight originating from Homer has the option of picking up tickets at Ninilchik and Kasilof before flying to Soldotna to register. **Float Plane participants may drive to the MARC hangar to register and enjoy breakfast before flying or pre-register at the Kenai Airport Manager's office. If you require special accommodations for registration, please call 283-7951.**
  2. **Fly to at least 5 airports listed below and pick up a ticket from the Air Fair bucket.** Participants receive up to 7 playing cards and play the best 5 cards. Ticket stations open at 8am and close at 2pm.
  3. Present tickets to the **POKER RUN TABLE** at the Kenai Airport Operations Facility, 515 N. Willow, Kenai, **before 2:30pm** on June 4<sup>th</sup>. Prizes awarded at 3:00 pm.
  4. Floatplane pilots can call the Airport Manager at 398-6412 or the Tower upon arrival to arrange for transportation from the float plane basin to the OPS facility for the afternoon events.
